Background

The Fulbright Program is celebrating its 75th Anniversary in 2021. Throughout the year, the U.S. Department of State's Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs and our Fulbright partners across the world are highlighting the impressive accomplishments of Fulbright alumni, the legacy of the program, and Fulbright's impacts on education, industries, culture, and communities. Higher education institutions are key to the Fulbright Program's success, and we invite your communications team to promote the anniversary on your campus and to your alumni and local communities by using the resources in this toolkit.

We launched a dedicated 75th anniversary website (www.fulbright75.org) and are updating it throughout the year to showcase alumni stories related to monthly themes. It includes a calendar of anniversary events and activities (which we hope you will contribute to), highlights from the program's history, and many other digital elements.

To join the celebration honoring 75 years of the Fulbright Program, we encourage you to carry out two main objectives:

- 1. Celebrating on Your Campus-** Host and promote anniversary activities and events, virtual and/or in-person. We encourage you to include stories of your young professionals, in addition to your Fulbright alumni who may be more established in their fields, to help us inspire the next generation of Fulbrighters.

75th Anniversary Themes:

- Fulbright 75th Anniversary celebratory activities and communications have two overarching communications goals – to illustrate the positive impact of the program on individuals, institutions, and communities and to illustrate and amplify diversity within Fulbright in all of its forms so that the program is truly reflective of the United States. In addition to the traditional celebrations of specific months, such as Black History Month and Women’s History Month, which we highlight every year, 2021 has been divided into four quarterly focus areas and 12 monthly communications themes as follows:

We encourage our institutional partners to promote any 75th Anniversary news, events, and activities to all of your relevant foreign Fulbrighters and U.S. Fulbright alumni networks, including the *Fulbrighter* online networking platform (<https://fulbrighternetwork.com/>) and the

- Work with your campus newspaper and alumni magazine staff to publish an article about your Fulbright alumni. Interview high profile alumni and program stakeholders to include in your university's newspaper or blog.
- Host a “#Fulbright75 Week” (or Day) event, using some of the ideas below.
- Host a 75th anniversary reception (virtual or in-person) for foreign Fulbrighters and U.S. Fulbright alumni on campus.
- Establish a regular Fulbright 75th Coffee Break or Evening on campus (virtual or in-person, when possible). Rotating activities could include:
 - Fulbright alumni share their Fulbright stories and research.
 - Current foreign Fulbrighters on campus can discuss their research and their home country.
 - “Speed Talks,” similar to speed dating, in which students can speak to alumni and foreign Fulbrighters on campus about the program, their home country, the host country experience, and more. Other formats could include providing application tips for potential applicants, selecting a host country, and service project ideas.
- Work with the Foreign Language Teaching Assistants on campus to organize a language and culture fair, and, if possible, partner with a local school or schools and/or the local public library.
